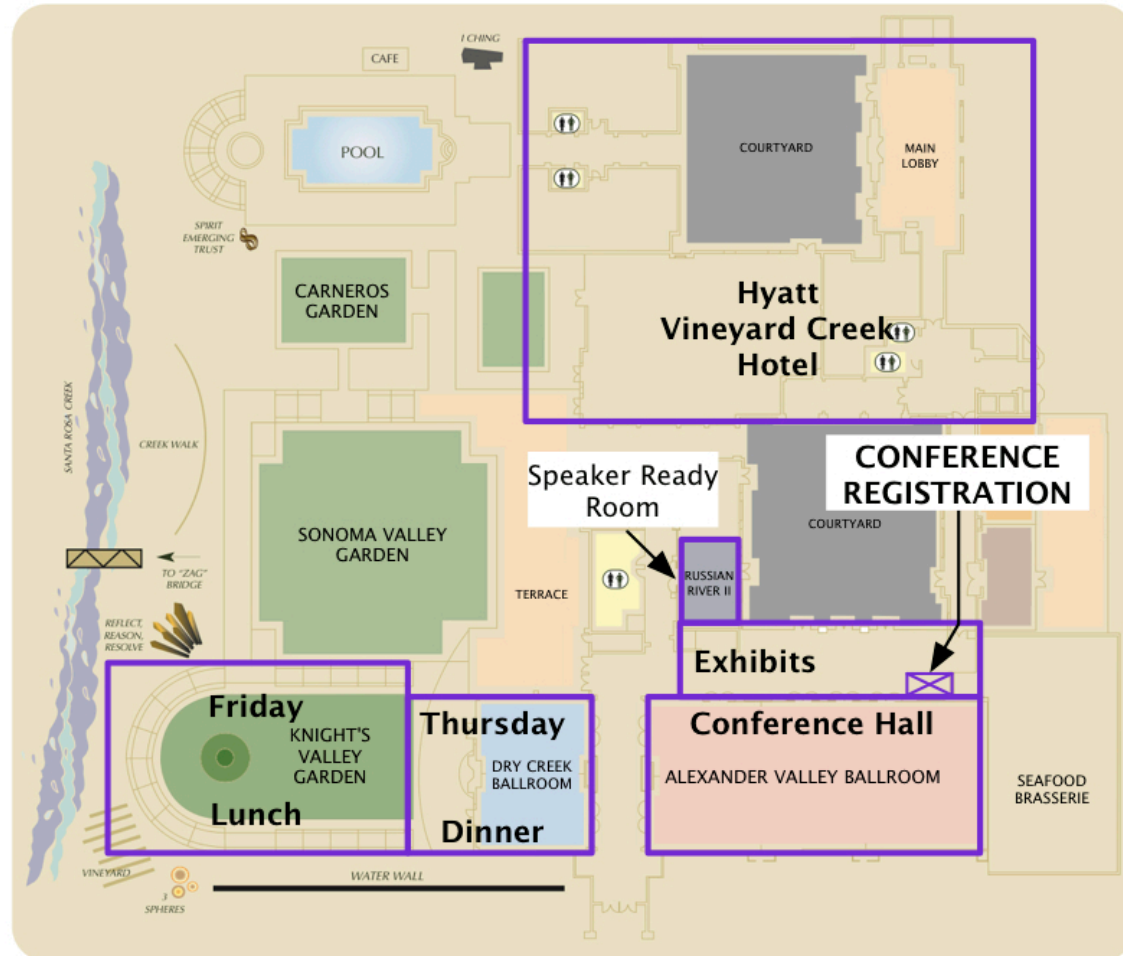

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Redwood MedNet 2011 HIE Expansion Projects

1. UnitedHealthcare Second Generation ePrescribing
2. HFNSC eOrders
3. Cal eConnect HIE Expansion
4. Cal eConnect Direct Project
5. Santa Rosa Memorial Hospital bidirectional HIE services
6. Pfizer Community Care Platform

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Redwood MedNet Second Generation ePrescribing

1. Expand ePrescribing among safety net providers
2. Enable electronic capture of community clinic dispensary prescribing (i.e., local patient data missing from all other eRx services)
3. Test HIE as a tool for medication reconciliation
4. Funded by a grant from UnitedHealthcare



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Redwood MedNet eOrders Project

1. Enable three local community clinics to place laboratory test orders electronically
2. Enable testing laboratory at local Critical Access Hospital to receive inbound electronic orders from EHRs

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Redwood MedNet Cal eConnect HIE Expansion

- 18 month project - - June 2011 to November 2012
- 7 hospitals
- 12 ambulatory practices
- 2 public health departments
- 80 specific deliverables
- New data types
 - Immunization reporting
 - Syndromic surveillance
 - Transitions in care clinical messaging

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Redwood MedNet Cal eConnect Direct Project

- 6 month project - - June 2011 to November 2011
- Direct Messaging to report immunizations to the California Immunization Registry (CAIR)
- Direct messaging for transitions of care between hospitals and skilled nursing facilities

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Redwood MedNet Bidirectional HIE Messaging

- Contract with Santa Rosa Memorial Hospital to expand HIE messaging services
- Bidirectional clinical data exchange with Healdsburg District Hospital (Critical Access Hospital)
- Bidirectional clinical data exchange with three community clinics in Northern Sonoma County
 - Alliance Medical Center (FQHC)
 - Alexander Valley Regional Medical Center (RHC)
 - Healdsburg Primary Care

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Redwood MedNet Community Care Platform

- Contract with Pfizer, Inc. to test HIE tools for building patient cohorts
- Enables longitudinal quality registries
- Overview of project to date will be presented Friday afternoon by Michael Hogarth, MD, principal investigator
