Registration Policies

By completing and submitting this registration form Attendee agrees to the following registration policies.

- By registering to attend a Redwood MedNet (RWMN) conference event, you consent to collection and storage of your user account and event registration details.
- By registering to attend a RWMN conference event, you provide permission to receive e-mails, mailings and faxes related to RWMN events. If you wish to opt out of receiving any of these communications you may do so during the online registration process, or by e-mailing registration@redwoodmednet.org, or by using the e-mail unsubscribe link on the RWMN homepage.
- By registering to attend a RWMN conference event, you agree to provide true, accurate, current and complete information about yourself ("User Registration Data") as prompted by the steps in the registration process. If we have reason to believe that you failed to provide true and complete information then we may suspend or terminate your user account, and we may cancel your future use of our event registration system.
- By registering to attend a RWMN conference event, you agree to indemnify and hold RWMN and its officers, directors, affiliates, partners, agents, suppliers and representatives harmless from any claim or demand, including reasonable attorney's fees, made by any third party due to or arising out of your: (i) violation of these policies, or (ii) violation of applicable law or (iii) violation of the rights of any third party based on or related to your use of the event facility.

- Cancellation and substitution requests must be submitted in writing to registration@redwoodmednet.org, or faxed to 707.462.5015. Substitution requests for the 2015 Conference will be accepted until Friday, July 24, 2015.
- Cancellation requests received on or prior to Tuesday, June 30, 2015 qualify for a refund of the amount paid, less a 20% processing and administration fee.
- Cancellation requests received after Tuesday, June 30, 2015 and before the end of Friday, July 24, 2015 qualify for a refund of the amount paid, less a 50% processing and administration fee.
- If you cancel your registration and qualify for a refund, expect the refund within 30 days. Refunds will be issued back to the original payment type.
- Cancellation requests received on or after Saturday, July 25, 2015 (one week before the conference) do not qualify for a refund.
- Confirmed registrations for Attendees who do not attend, cancel, donate or transfer their registration by Friday, July 24, 2015 are liable for the full conference registration payment.
- Hotel accommodation costs are not included in the conference registration payment. Attendees are responsible for making their own lodging arrangements.
- Local, state, and federal laws apply at the event facility.
- RWMN will not be held responsible for any loss, injury or damage to property, whatever the cause. Attendees participate in conference events at their own risk.
